



IBF 2027 – General Terms & conditions

Version: July2026

Article 1 – Scope and Applicability

These General Terms and Conditions govern participation in the ITER Business Forum 2027 (IBF/27), including registrations, exhibition bookings, sponsorships, speaking engagements, partnerships, and related payments.

They apply to all participants, exhibitors, sponsors, speakers, partners, suppliers, contractors, delegates, and visitors.

By registering for or participating in IBF/27, all parties agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions. Any conflicting terms shall not apply unless expressly accepted in writing by the Organiser.

The Organiser may issue additional operational, technical, safety, or event-specific rules, which shall form part of these Terms and Conditions.

If any provision is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain fully applicable.

These Terms and Conditions shall be read together with any specific rules applicable to exhibition, sponsorship, networking, business meetings, hosted events, or other IBF/27 activities.

Article 2 – Definitions

Organiser : Commissariat à l'Énergie Atomique et aux Énergies Alternatives (CEA), acting through Agence ITER France, organiser of IBF/27.

Visitor : Any person or entity attending the Event without exhibition or sponsorship participation.

Exhibitor: Any organisation reserving exhibition space at IBF/27.

Sponsor : Any organisation entering into a sponsorship agreement with the Organiser.

Participant : Any individual registered to attend the Event.

Speaker : Any individual participating in the official programme as a presenter, moderator or contributor.

Partner : Any institutional, industrial or media organisation formally associated with the Event.

Registration : The submission and acceptance of an application to participate in the Event.

Agreement : The contractual relationship between the Organiser and a Participant, Exhibitor, Sponsor or Partner.

Article 3 : Registration and Payment

The obligation to pay arises upon confirmation of registration, exhibition booking, sponsorship agreement, or any other participation package.

Participation is only confirmed once full payment has been received by the Organiser.

All invoices must be paid within the period specified on the invoice. Unless otherwise stated, payment shall be made within thirty (30) days from the invoice date.

Payments must be made in Euros (€) by bank transfer or credit card only. Cheques will not be accepted.

All fees must be paid in full prior to the opening of IBF/27. The Organiser reserves the right to suspend or cancel participation rights in the event of non-payment.

Article 4 : Cancellation by Participants

Cancellations must be submitted in writing to the organiser at registration@iterbusinessforum.com.

- Cancellations received before 1 march 2027 : full refund
- Cancellations between 1 and 31 march 2027 : 50% refund minus €100 administrative fee.
- Cancellations from 1 april 2027 onwards: no refund.

No refunds are made for failure to attend, late arrival, early departure, cancelled sessions, or programme changes.

A cancellation is only valid once AIF/CEA confirms receipt.

Article 5 – Programme Changes and Event Cancellation

The Organiser reserves the right to modify the programme, speakers, venue, exhibition layout, schedule or any other aspect of the Event.

Should the Event be cancelled, postponed or significantly modified, the Organiser shall determine the applicable refund policy.

Article 6 – Exhibition Rules

Exhibitors shall comply with all technical, operational, safety and security requirements communicated by the Organiser.

Booths may not be transferred, shared or sublet without prior written approval.

Article 7 – Liability and Insurance

Participants attend and participate at their own risk.

Exhibitors are solely responsible for the transportation, storage, installation, operation, supervision and removal of their equipment and materials. The Exhibitor cannot place in the stand anything that could damage visitors and other exhibitors. All damage or harm caused by its structures, equipment, articles to be exhibited or activities in its stand, as well as actions of the subcontractor firms, when these firms harm visitors and other exhibitors is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor. The Organiser shall not be liable for any loss, theft, damage, injury, business interruption or indirect damages arising from participation in the Event.

Exhibitors and sponsors are responsible for arranging appropriate insurance coverage for their personnel, equipment and activities.

Article 8 – Intellectual Property

All trademarks, logos, presentations, publications and materials displayed during the Event remain the property of their respective owners.

Participation in the Event does not grant any intellectual property rights unless expressly agreed in writing.

Article 9 – Photography, Filming and Recordings

Participants acknowledge that photographs, video recordings and other media may be captured during the Event and used by the Organiser for communication, promotional and archival purposes.

Individuals who do not wish to appear in such materials are invited to notify the Organiser or the official photographer/videographer on site.

Article 10 – Data Protection

Personal data shall be processed in accordance with applicable European and French data protection legislation, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Further information is available in the IBF/27GDPR document.

Article 11 – Governing Law and Final Provisions

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by French law.

Any dispute arising in connection with IBF/27 shall fall within the jurisdiction of the competent courts of Marseille, France.

The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Updated versions shall be published on the official IBF/27 website.
